Assembly Presentation (grades 3 - 8)

Impossible Things and Big Dreams

In this 45-minute program intended for larger audiences, Lindsay introduces kids to *All the Impossible Things*, and shares facts from science and history that seem impossible, but are true! This interactive session not only presents kids with amazing information, but also introduces them to real life-kids whose big dreams changed the world. By the end, students will hopefully come to believe that their dreams matter, too, and that nothing is impossible!

Writing Workshop (grades 4 - 6)

Wants, But, So... Drafting with Your Character in Mind

Designed for smaller groups of up to 25 students, this 45-minute program introduces kids to Lindsay and her process for working out a first draft of a story with character motivations in mind. Students walk through Lindsay's "Wants, But, So..." method, learn from examples, and collaborate with the author on the first draft of a short story.

Classroom Visit (grades 1 - 8)

Q&A with Lindsay

This 30-minute classroom visit includes a brief talk from Lindsay that can correlate to your school's philosophical mission, such as positive character development, and briefly discusses Lindsay's writing journey, followed by Q&A with the author.

Skype Visit (all ages)

Classroom visits can be adapted to a Skype visit. Lindsay also offers a limited number of FREE 20-minute Skype Q&A visits each year.
